The Gmul Track will be comprised of the following:

ETAI Annual Summer Conference (in person) – 12 hours

Spring Conference or Winter Conference (completed) – 6 hours

One mini-conference or two – 4 hours each

Two ETAI webinars of your choosing (instead of one mini-conference) – 4 hours

Asynchronous tasks – 4 hours (One online webinar of your choosing from a given selection, and the time invested in preparing the final task.)

- ❖ You must attend 30 hours to be eligible for the in-service training credit (gmul).
- ❖ After each event that you attend, you must complete an attendance and reflection form.
- ❖ You must submit a final task following the summer conference within two weeks. Your task will be based on your reflections on your event participation; therefore you must keep copies of all your attendance and reflection forms. The exact instructions for the task will be posted shortly.
- ❖ You may choose to use the ministry Zoom in Zoom Out conference on March 8th or the ministry Special Education conference on February 1st instead of a mini-conference or two webinars. Be in touch with Karen to get the feedback form.
- ❖ **All participants will have to register with the Pisgah to get the gmul. Information to come.**
