



Instructions for downloading The English Club app v2 from the Apple App Store

- Set up an Apple ID and password for the school, and set up a payment method (such as a school credit card). Note the ID and password for future use. Keep it confidential so it isn't used for unauthorized purposes. (You will only log into this ID long enough to purchase what you want from the App Store, then log out so that it can't be used for unauthorized purchases.)
- Connect the Apple mobile device (e.g. iPad) to Wi-fi (Settings > Wi-Fi and locate the wi-fi server; it should show it is connected with a check mark next to the server name.)
- Log in to the Apple ID that has a method of payment for the App Store set up:

On your device tap Settings. Go into iTunes and App Stores. In the field for Apple ID sign out of whatever ID is currently being used, then enter the Apple ID that has a payment method set up, and enter its password. (You should note what Apple ID was being used on the device so you can log back in when you have completed the purchase.)

- **If you installed the previous version of The English Club, delete it before reinstalling so you will enjoy the new full iPad support of Version 2.**
- Tap the icon on the device for the App Store, and search for The English Club. You should recognize the cartoon, above.
- Download/install the first two free levels of the app – choose learner language “English” (upcoming Version 2 will have learner languages of Arabic and Spanish; and if you have any Hebrew-only speakers, that too is available in V1). You will have two blue boxes (downloaded levels) and the rest will still be brown (levels yet to be purchased and downloaded).
- To obtain the other 48 levels of material, activate the app – view the introductory tutorial in the green box – then choose the “Store” tab/icon on the right side at the bottom of the home screen (the shelves of lessons) as explained in the introduction. Choose the Gold Pack up on the store shelf and confirm you want to buy it; you might need to re-enter the password of the user ID.
- The gold pack of 48 lessons of material should download and install. It's a lot of material so it takes a little while, be patient!

You will know that all the material is installed when all the lesson boxes on the lesson shelves in the home screen of the app turn from brown to blue.

- If more than one learner will use the device (for example, at different hours of the school day) you can install the Multi-User pack, also from the in-app store. Tap on the striped box on the top right of the pile on the store table and confirm that you want to download it. (The price is the same as the gold pack, and it supports an unlimited number of learners on the same device.) After you install this, when you go back to the Levels screen, you will be prompted to set up the first learner – their first name is the username, and their last name is the password.

The app will stay logged in for a given learner until you add another learner and log in to that account instead (there is a small head in the upper left of the Levels screen that will take you to the new user setup and login screen.)

- Once all the boxes have turned blue, you are ready to go! Remember that the learner has to complete all the activities in a level (and confirm that the material was completed by “stamping” the card or activity) to unlock the next level.
- You can specify for the device (in Settings, look for The English Club settings) how much review to provide in each level (how many levels back to review, and the maximum number of cards of each color per review). Weaker learners may need more review (though they won't like it) and learners who remember more easily may need less.
- To prevent misuse of the user ID with access to the credit card, return to Settings, go into iTunes and App Stores, and sign out of the Apple ID with the credit card associated with it, then log back in to the usual Apple ID without a payment method set up, and enter its password. Proceed to use the device to learn!
- Version 2 is free to owners of the current version. The new version has improved iPad resolution, easier navigation, Spanish and Arabic learner languages, and a multi-user pack (for the price of one additional gold pack of 50 lessons, the app keeps track of the individual progress of an unlimited number of learners).
